I joined the plastic surgery training programme in Mumbai, India following 3 years of general surgery training. I enjoyed my basic plastic surgery training in King Edward Memorial Hospital, Bombay and passed the M.Ch (Plastic Surgery) examination. I had an opportunity to do clinical fellowship in the Department of Plastic Surgery at the Tata Memorial Cancer Hospital, Bombay, which gave me a wide exposure of head and neck reconstruction. I had the good fortune of doing a short-term fellowship in the Department of Plastic Surgery at the Sahlgrenska Hospital, Gotoberg, Sweden, and St. Markus Hospital, Frankfurt, Germany, as a travelling fellow of the Association of Plastic Surgeons of India. This gave me a wide exposure in cosmetic surgery, breast reconstruction, cleft and craniofacial surgery. CLINICAL EXPERIENCE IN PLASTIC SURGERY

Aesthetic Plastic Surgery:

I gained extensive training in aesthetic plastic surgery as a clinical fellow at the Sahlgrenska Hospital Gutenberg (Sweden), St Marcus Hospital Frankfurt (Germany) and higher surgical training program rotating in various plastic surgical units in UK. My commitment at Golden Jubilee Hospital Glasgow (UK) as a consultant plastic surgeon involved predominantly aesthetic surgery for a period of six years.

I am in private practice in London for the last eight years performing aesthetic facial and body contouring surgery.

Melanoma and Skin Cancer:

I gained a unique exposure of multidisciplinary team management of melanoma and skin cancer in the largest melanoma centre in the United Kingdom at St. George's Hospital. This included 'hands on' operative experience of sentinel node biopsy, lymph node dissections and reconstruction of defects following wide local excision of skin cancer. I had an opportunity to manage patients in the Combined Plastic, Radiology and Dermatology (PRD) clinics and participated in the multidisciplinary melanoma meetings.

Head and Neck Surgery:

Tata Memorial Cancer Hospital, Bombay, is the largest cancer hospital in India for multidisciplinary cancer treatment. I was fortunate to do a fellowship in the Plastic and Reconstructive Department and had 'hands on' experience in reconstruction of defects following cancer excision, particularly in the head/neck region. I continued gaining extensive exposure to head and neck reconstruction during my general plastic surgery training in Oxford, Liverpool, Sheffield, Hull and Exeter.

Breast Reconstruction:

I have vast 'hands on' experience in primary as well as secondary breast reconstruction in various Plastic Surgery Units in the United Kingdom. I have attended advanced courses on breast reconstruction organised by the British Association of Plastic Surgery. I have also attended an Autologous Breast Reconstruction and Perforated Based Flap Course in Munich.

Paediatric Plastic Surgery:

I acquired extensive exposure to paediatric plastic surgery at the Great Ormond Street Hospital, London, as well as Sheffield Children's Hospital, Sheffield. This included cleft lip and palate, craniofacial surgery, congenital hand, ear reconstruction, vascular malformations and congenital urogenital surgery.

GENERAL PLASTIC SURGERY AND TRAUMA

United Kingdom:

I enjoyed working as Registrar/Senior Registrar in plastic surgery in various units in the U.K. I had an opportunity to upgrade my training in general plastic surgery, major reconstructive procedures, microvascular surgery, hypospadias, breast reconstruction and oculoplastic surgery. I continued to manage emergencies and general plastic surgery problems independently, becoming exposed to different approaches.

India:

The King Edward Memorial Hospital, Bombay, is a teaching hospital having 60 beds for plastic surgery and 12 beds for acute burns. I learnt the basic techniques of plastic surgery including skin grafts, local flaps, management of burns, acute hand injuries, maxillofacial trauma, lower limb reconstruction and reconstruction of post burn deformities. I was involved in participating in reconstruction of congenital and acquired hand and face deformities. I participated in microvascular flaps, limb and digit re-implantations and craniofacial surgery. During my training in plastic surgery, I passed my Masters Examination in Bombay University.
