Mr Riaz has worked as a Consultant Plastic, Reconstructive & Aesthetic Surgeon since 1998 and is currently working in the UK for Hull University Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust and also through local private hospitals in the Region. Mr Riaz also has recently started working from MACS Clinic, Watford. He graduated in 1983 from Nishtar Medical College in Pakistan and finished his post-graduation in general surgery in 1991 in the UK. Following that he trained in Plastic Surgery in the UK and Ireland and obtained FRCS (Plast) in 1998. He worked as a Consultant in Belfast before returning to Pakistan. He had the passion to do voluntary work for his parent institution which he did from 1999-2001 for three years and established a Burn & Plastic Surgery Unit in Nishtar Hospital, Multan. Mr Riaz returned to the UK in January 2002 and also went to spend some time with a very renowned group of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons in Atlanta, USA, before taking his substantive Consultant Plastic Surgeon post in Hull from January 2004.
